Each year, a mission team from St. Michael's journeys to the Ukraine to provide Biblical teaching, healing prayer, food for the poor, and Christian love. But we also provide funds for medical and other dire needs.

Most Americans are unaware of the fact that, even in 2009, the Ukraine's agrarian economy still runs on man-and-mule muscle. Families using little more than hoes work at a fevered pitch to get crops in the ground during the short growing season—crops that will keep them alive through the brutal winter.

Last year, supporters like you gave enough money for our Ukrainian friend, Pastor Peter Chernyvaskyy, to purchase a used tractor. This God-sent, diesel powered, evangelism machine can do the labor of a hundred men in a single day—free of charge—and to the villagers of the Ukraine, it is nothing less than a miracle.

On any mission trip, some work is supernatural and some is more practical, and this tractor is a wonderful symbol of that. Wouldn't you be more apt to attend a church if the Pastor showed up at your home and saved you a month's worth of work—for free?
